



HOW THE GOVERNMENT FUNDING WORKS

Each child is entitled to 15/30 hours of funded education per week, depending on your family circumstances commencing in the term after their third birthday. Any hours attended over this amount will be billed by the Pre School. We also charge a small fee for snack. To see if you are entitled to 30 hours of funding, please visit www.childrenchoices.co.uk

When enrolling your child, you will need to plan ahead! If you would like 15/30 hours per week you will need to book it as soon as possible to secure your hours. It is not always possible to give extra hours to children half way through a term, so ideally parents should consider what hours they want for their child at the beginning of the school year.

We do our very best to accommodate our parents' wishes and needs, and we can be approached at any time regarding availability of extra hours so please don't hesitate to ask!

We need to see your child's birth certificate when he/she joins us so we can secure government funding for you.

Pre School days are made up as follows:

Am session only – 9.00am – 12.00pm = 3 hours

Full day session – 9.00am – 3.00pm = 6 hours

We offer an early bird session from 8.30am – 9.00am (not part of the government funding) at a cost of £5
